A Glimpse into the Extraordinary Life of my Octogenarian Granny

My grandma had a tough life growing up during World War II and sometimes she tells me stories from her childhood and youth. They are really great stories especially because they are true life stories. Since she is not able to tell them to you herself, I thought I'd do a short interview. I hope you'll enjoy reading it as much as I do listening to her.

1. Could you tell me a few words about yourself?

My maiden name is Moldoveanu Ilinca and I was brought up by my mother in a family of three in the village of Chiscani, 10 km from Braila. My father disappeared in the war when I was 9. I later became a dentist, I got married when I was 25 to a university professor and we had two children.

I still remember from my childhood that we had an immense garden,

a kind of orchard, with a great variety of fruit-bearing trees. Still, those of our neighbours were tastier. We would, time and time again, "visit" her, no matter how strong the shame of being caught was. The winters were the most spectacular of them all. The most fun we had was ice-skating on the frozen Danube. The skates were handmade by us. Even though the ice would sometimes break under us, or we would fall and acquire some mighty bruises, it was all worth it. Before the Russians came, there were the Germans. I gladly remember them since they were kind to people. Because our house was one of the biggest in the village, it was transformed into a sort of headquarters during the war. Every morning the Germans would go to Braila and take me with them to get tutored.

2. How was life before and during World War II in that part of the country?

With the start of the Second World War, the majority of the people fled from their villages, retreating to the Braila Pond because of the Russians. I remember that they stole our horses when they came. After they settled, I recall watching them play Kazaciok. Every evening, there would be the same ritual: partying and dancing and, if it weren't for the fear that we had, the dances would've been quite amazing. To the upmost bafflement and disappointment of the Russians, they did not find any girl in the village. To keep the food away from them, we had to hide it in the barn.

3. What was it like under communism and how did it affected the life of your family?

The arrival of communism meant only a disaster for our family. My mother was locked away for being a landlady since they needed her wealth. Even though they did not simply take it away, the taxes were so high that it seemed the land was not even ours. After my mother was released from prison, army lists came, searching every square inch to find our animals and to take them away.

Ever since I was a child I dreamt of becoming a doctor. I opted for Dentistry (which is "Stomatologie" in Romanian) thinking that it was related to the stomach. I was greatly surprised when I found out it wasn't quite like that, but I still went with it. It was difficult because I had to hide the fact that I was the daughter of a landlady, being under the constant threat of being kicked out of school. However I succeeded to become a dentist and then life started to be a bit better; I met your grandfather, which was love at first sight, and we moved to Maramureş where we made a life together.

most original way in order to recreate the spooky atmosphere of this Celtic festival. And what they have accomplished.... you can judge for yourselves...







D.I.Y - How to Make Your Very Own Heart Sweater

Hearthstone: Heroes of War craft

Hearthstone: Heroes of War craft is an upcoming free-to-play digital collectible card game (CCG) from Blizzard Entertainment.

Hearthstone is a collectible card game that revolves around turn-based online 1vs1 matches between two opponents, operated through Blizzard's Battle.net. Players can choose from a number of game modes, with each offering a slightly different experience. Players start the game with a substantial collection of 'basic' cards, but can gain rarer and more powerful cards through purchasing packs of additional cards, or as reward for competing in the Arena. Card packs and entry to the Arena can be purchased using real money, or 'gold', an in-game currency earned through completing special 'quests'.

Hearthstone is set within the *War craft* universe, with the majority of its characters and cards drawing from existing lore.

Hearthstone was first announced at Penny Arcade Expo in March 2013 for Windows, Mac, and iPad, with a release date of the same year. In August 2013, the game went into closed beta, to which over 1 million players had been invited as of November 8, 2013 with plans to enter open beta in December. Blizzard later announced that it would continue closed beta into 2014 despite their original estimation. Blizzard announced open beta for North America on January 21, 2014. Open beta was announced for Europe on January 22, 2014 and on January 23, 2014 it was made available in all regions.

Plans to release on Android and iPhone were announced in November 2013, with a release date sometime in the second half of 2014.

The Elder Scrolls Online

The Elder Scrolls Online is an upcoming massively multiplayer online role-playing video game developed by ZeniMax Online Studios, to be released in 2014.

It is a part of *The Elder Scrolls* video game franchise, of which it is the first openended multiplayer instalment.

As with other games in *The Elder Scrolls* franchise, the game will be set in the continent of Tamriel and feature a storyline indirectly connected with the other games. The game will be set a millennium before the events of *The Elder Scrolls V: Skyrim* and around 800 years before *The Elder Scrolls III*:

Morrowind and The Elder Scrolls IV: Oblivion, with the Daedric Prince Molag Bal appearing as the main antagonist as he attempts to pull all of Tamriel to his realm of Coldharbour.

As with Oblivion and Morrowind, there will be classes. In this particular game there will be four, these include: Dragon Knight, Templar, Sorcerer and Nightblade.

As in previous *Elder Scrolls* titles, the gameplay will be mostly nonlinear with a mixture of quests, random events, and encouragement for players to simply explore the world. The game has no offline mode, although the developers have stated that there will be "plenty of content" designed to accommodate players who prefer to play solo.

On August 21, 2013,it was announced that *The Elder Scrolls Online* will have a monthly subscription fee upon release for all platforms. The monthly fee is set at \$14.99. It was announced on January 28, 2014, that the game will not require a PlayStation Plus subscription to play online. *The Elder Scrolls Online*, however, on Xbox One will require an Xbox LIVE Gold subscription in addition to *The Elder Scrolls Online's* \$14.99 /mo. subscription.



The Walking Dead: Season Two

The Walking Dead: Season Two is an on-going episodic graphic adventure based on Robert Kirkman's The Walking Dead comic book series and developed by Telltale Games. It is the sequel to The Walking Dead, with the first episode released digitally in December 2013, and a retail collector's DVD edition planned at the conclusion of the season.

The game employs the same narrative structure as the first season, where player choice in one episode will have a permanent impact on future story elements. The player choices recorded in save files from the first season and the additional episode 400 Days carry over into the second season. Clementine, who was the player's companion during the first season, is the player-character in Season Two.

The Walking Dead: Season Two follows on the first game, and coincides with events of the comic, in which a zombie apocalypse has occurred, turning humans that are bitten or die into zombies, or "walkers"; the only way to stop this conversion is to damage the brain. As with the comic, the game takes place in the state of Georgia.

In the first season, Clementine is left at home with a babysitter as her parents go on vacation when these events start. Lee Everett, an ex-professor and convicted murderer, finds Clementine alone after the babysitter has turned, and helps to rescue her. The two join a group of survivors with plans to head to Savannah, where Clementine's parents had gone to as well as hopes to find a boat to flee the mainland. As they travel, Lee helps to teach Clementine about survival in this new world, and the two bond closely. Their movements are tracked by an unknown man who wanted to get revenge on the group after they ransacked his car and caused the loss of his wife to walkers. Once in Savannah, the man kidnaps Clementine, and in his haste to find her, Lee is bitten by a walker, but with help from the remnants of his group including Omid and Christa, he is able to reach the man before he turns. He rescues Clementine from the stranger, but by the time they escape, Lee has nearly lost his human side. Lee gives Clementine final bits of advice and tells her to find Omid and Christa, and then may urge her to shoot him to prevent him from turning fully. This is a choice left to the player, but regardless of the option, Clementine escapes the city and begins to search for her friends.

Following the events of the first season, Clementine was able to regroup with Omid and Christa, and Christa is now in the late months of the pregnancy that was revealed in Season One. However, while stopping at an abandoned service station to clean up, Omid is killed by a scavenger using Clementine's gun that she set down for a moment, before the scavenger is herself killed by Christa. Sixteen months later, Christa has apparently lost her child and her relationship with Clementine has become strained. When they are set on by scavengers, Clementine is separated from Christa and falls into a nearby river. Separated from the only living soul she knew, Clementine is forced to survive on her own.
